Focused on training the lay rescuer, the Emergency First Response approach to training builds confidence in lay rescuers and increases their willingness to respond when faced with a medical emergency by teaching them the skills they need in a non-stressful learning environment. Participants are also given as much practice as necessary to master and retain these skills.

Emergency First Response Certifications are good for 2 years after which a refresher course is recommended.

## **CPR/Automatic External Defibrillator Certification**

Notice to SAMPLE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS:

Statistically, when a person's heart stops, they're chance of a successful recovery decreases by 7-10 percent for every minute that the body is deprived of oxygen. This means that a victim of a heart attack has little chance of successful recovery after just 10 minutes. In most instances, from the time an emergency occurs to the time EMS physically arrives on scene, 10 minutes has probably passed. "Trained" first responders, significantly increase the chances that a victim of a heart related emergency has at recovery.

Area schools have implemented AED's (Automatic External Defibrillator) for the safety and benefit of students, employees and visitors. When used in conjunction with CPR, AED's are the single most important tool in providing critical help to a victim that has suffered a heart related injury. Additionally, many public places today have an AED on the premises; schools, churches, stores, government buildings, etc. Places where many people congregate are most likely to have an AED readily available in the event of an emergency. Too often though, a trained individual is not so readily available.

As a "trained" first responder, you may significantly increase the chances that a victim of a heart related emergency has at recovery.

SAMPLE SCHOOL is making available CPR/AED training and certification classes to all high school students, their families and school employees. The cost of the program is \$55 per person with a \$100 max. per family unit. Upon completion, each student will be fully trained in CPR, use of an AED, and in choking emergencies for adults, children and infants based upon the "revised" 2010 American Heart Association standards. In the event of an emergency at school or at the grocery store, or at church, you will be a trained emergency responder and able to provide emergency care (CPR/AED) to a victim, helping them until EMS arrives.

The typical course runs approximately 4 to 6 hrs. In addition to video instruction, students complete bookwork, a final exam and have a lot of fun practicing skills in a multitude of actual emergency scenarios. Each student, after learning necessary skills using manikins, takes part in live drills, taking charge of an emergency situation involving a fellow student. Everyone works as a team in each emergency scenario. This course is simply not just to receive a certification card, but teaches and prepares each student to become a "confident" Emergency First Responder.
